Statement of hearing officer: Highlights of these charges were read into the record.

Officer Lee explained that he did not fill out the off-duty request because he thought he would only work for a short period of time, perhaps one weekend. He assured the Hearing Officer that had this off-duty employment turned into a long-term event, he would have completed the off-duty documents.

Lt. Williams, who represented Officer Lee, confirmed that Officer Lee had no intention of keeping his off-duty employment from the police department.

Officer Lee presented a letter of confirmation from the Principal, Mr. Sammy Hall, at the school where he works. The letter speaks to Officer Lee's integrity.

The Hearing Officer took into consideration the events surrounding the incident which disclosed the off-duty violation of Officer Lee, and is satisfied that the case warrants only a reprimand.

Action Ordered: Written Reprimand

Any employee holding a position not exempted from the provisions of Article 34 Civil Service, and not in the initial probationary period, who has been suspended in excess of ten (10) days, terminated, or demoted, may appeal to the Civil Service Commission with in ten (10) calendar days after notification in writing of such action. In the event of multiple suspensions, only that suspension which causes the total ;number od days suspended to exceed five (5) days within a six month period, and any subsequent suspension within said period shall be appealable to the Commission.
